

# Create your collage

- start with a base fabric which will become your lining/reverse side
- lay base fabric wrong side up
- design collage
- use spray adhesive to hold pieces in place
- “quilt” layers together
- add bias tape to cover raw edges
- each garment piece is collaged separately, then garment is sewn together

# Slicing

- adds surface texture
- reveals peek of under fabric
- sew parallel rows 1/2" to 1" apart
- stitching and cutting must be on true bias
- cut between rows of stitching  
- do not cut base layer!

## **Hong Kong edge finish**

**Cut bias strips 2" wide.  
Sew on 1/2" from edge.**

**Wrap strip around raw edge,  
press.**

**Pin in place, stitch in the ditch.  
Trim away excess.**

**Position single fold bias tape just  
over stitching.  
Edgestitch along both sides.**
