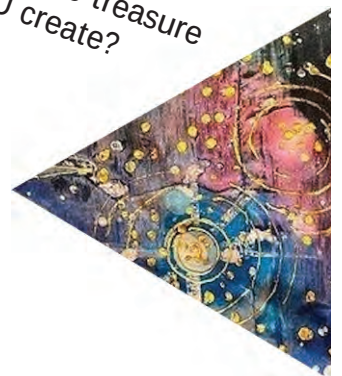

You will need & may already have:

A garment you would like to embellish
(can be new, used, or recycled)

A spoon, preferably metal

An iron – small craft or sewing iron is fine

A hair dryer

A brush – for using adhesive. (probably will not be reusable)

An old credit card, other stiff plastic that size, or a palette knife

A stencil or something you can cut a stencil out of, like contact paper

Masking tape
